"I love **ABSTRACTS** like this Duane Gardner piece 'Pequeno,' because they are not definite and make you think.

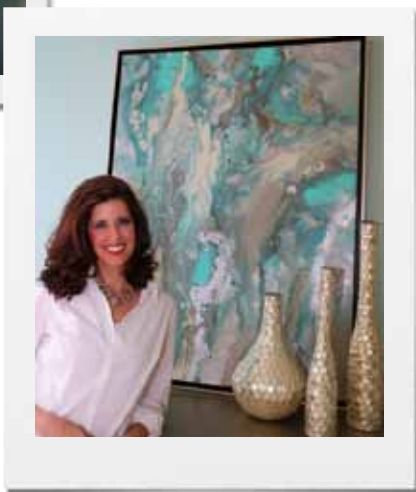
They have the ability to be something **DIFFERENT** for each observer."

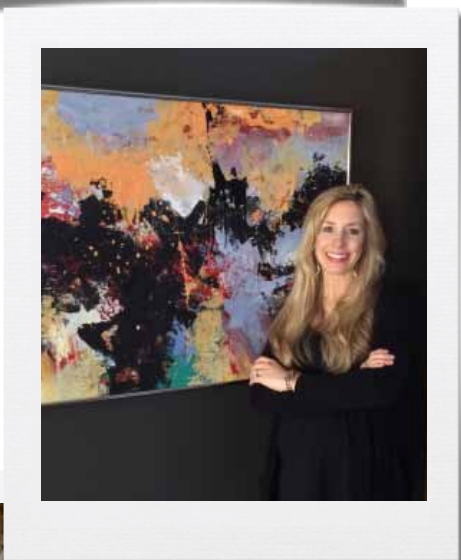
